PUMP LIFT STATIONS + GREASE INTERCEPTORS

Pump stations and grease interceptors often work together in wastewater systems—especially in facilities like restaurants, food processing plants, or large commercial kitchens. Ideally, designers strive for gravity in, gravity out grease interceptors. However, there are many other variables that impact the decision on what products are used.

In a recent application, there was a zero lot line application that included ground floor shops and restaurants topped by offices along a pedestrian promenade. Space was at a minimum, and the location provided limited options.

With no space for gravity type grease interceptors and location making it difficult to service, Highland Tank was able to provide stainless steel automatic grease interceptors designed to skim grease into adjacent grease storage that can be carted off or pumped to location for easy service.

Additionally, the automatic grease interceptors had to be located well below the building's sanitary connection.

Highland Tank also provided stainless steel sump and duplex pumps and controls that will pump effluent up to the sanitary connection.
